Especially pay attention to the following things: (1) the teachers/leaders – how were alike or different?, (2) the owners, (3) the physical layout of the rooms, (4) other types of dancing done there (i.e., non-Israeli), (5) non-dance elements (the food, talking, etc., and (6) your personal reaction to each of the venues.

HOW TO FIND A CAFÉ EVENING
